What is the seedling program?

The Massachusetts Tree Wardens' and Foresters' Association (MTWFA) sponsors an annual packaged seedling program as a popular way to help municipalities, garden clubs, businesses, arborists and other interested individuals and organizations promote Arbor Day.

Net proceeds from the seedling program support the MTWFA Scholarship Fund. Scholarships are awarded annually in March to students enrolled in arboriculture and urban forestry programs statewide. For more information, please visit

How do the seedlings arrive?

The package includes seedling trees and printed plastic bags with planting instructions. Bags are shipped separately, usually early April for orders scheduled for delivery during Arbor Day week.

Upon delivery, the seedlings can be placed in the plastic bags along with potting soil or peat moss, for distribution to school children and other Arbor Day participants.

Seedlings are shipped via UPS. Please note that UPS does NOT deliver to P.O. boxes. Someone should be present when the seedlings arrive, especially during warm weather.

Seedlings must be delivered by May 15th.

How are the seedlings priced?

The price list includes 2-year-old and 3-year-old evergreen and deciduous tree seedlings. Seedling size and prices vary. See the price list for more details.

All seedling prices include bags, ties, shipping and handling.

What are the minimum orders?

Minimum order *for each species*: **100**

Minimum order for pre-bagged seedlings: **300**

How can you distribute the seedlings?

Check with your local school department or municipality to obtain approval and an estimate of the quantities you will require. Distribution of the seedlings may be accompanied by a ceremony or presentation promoting Arbor Day, trees, and their value to people and the environment.

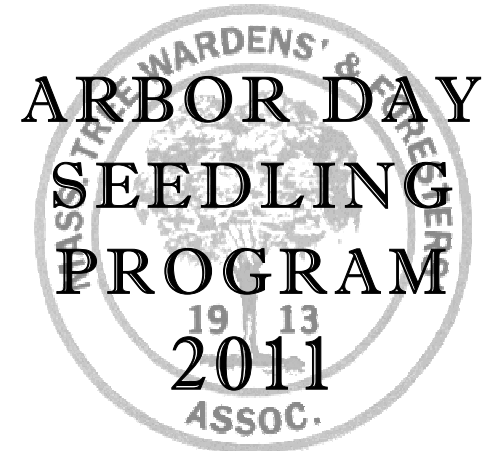
How do you place an order?

Fill out the order form on the reverse side. This form is also your invoice. We require at least 10 days between the time we receive your order and when the seedlings are delivered to you. Please plan accordingly.

Full payment is required with each order. Municipal purchase orders will be accepted at the time of order. Checks should be made payable to MTWFA.
