

PARK MAINTENANCE WORKER

The Department of Public Works is seeking a full-time Park Maintenance Worker. Duties include constructing, maintaining and repairing public properties and facilities such as parks, athletic fields, school grounds, conservation land, fences, signs, drains, ponds, river banks, playgrounds equipment, etc.

Manually digs and backfills excavations. Handles heavy materials on maintenance and construction projects using manual lifting techniques and power equipment. Performs semi-skilled building and construction work including painting, brick and stone masonry, and concrete and pavement work. Performs landscape and athletic field maintenance activities such as sowing grass, mowing, planting trees, fertilizing, mulching, etc. Performs manual labor as needed.

Requirements include a High School diploma or equivalent; a valid Class D driver's license; a valid Massachusetts Department of Safety Hoisting Engineer's License Classes 1C, 2C and 4G; and the ability to perform preventive maintenance on vehicles and equipment and to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

Preferred: One to three years' experience in maintaining athletic fields, park land and/or other types of grounds work. Wage range is \$14.77 - \$19.13/hour.
